BAIRD AND DEWAR SILVESTRA Dry Cider 750ml. 7.4% ABL

Only 196 cases of this wild-fermented dry cider were produced from heirloom and cider apples, hand pressed in early autumn and allowed to slowly vinify by native yeast present on the skin of the apples.

This unfiltered cider, which aged for one year in oak casks, is vaguely reminiscent of the late summer ciders of Spain and Basque region of France, and is yet uniquely Northwest.

BAIRD AND DEWAR FARMHOUSE Dry Cider 750ml. 7.9% ABL

Only 250 cases of this traditional dry cider were produced from local heirloom and cider apples, hand-pressed in the fall,then allowed to naturally ferment and mellow in oak barrels for five months.

The tradition of making hard cider each season dates back centuries to the small farms of France and England where the drink ranged from sour to light and mysterious libation which is rumored to have inspired french sparkling wine
